Explanation

Issues

Before sending document always check:

- Are all manually adjusted subjects stamped / signed by local vet ?
- Is tanknumber / sealnumbers filled in correctly?
- Has the local vet signed the document on page 5 with another color then black?
- Are all subjects striped out correctly as written in this document?
- Has the green sticker with the text "NOT FOR HUMAN OR ANIMAL CONSUMPTION" been placed on the tankcontainer ?
- Has the original HC been scanned to Neste Demeter ? (Scan of copy certificate is not allowed)
- Is the quality of the scanned HC good ? (If details on first page are not readable = rescan with higher resolution)
- That you only use the English HC.(Do not send the Dutch HC with truck or scan it to us)
- Do not change manually the pagenumbering, leave it as it is!!
